

Post-Election Audit Summary

May 2, 2017 Primary Election

Issue #8 – Brooklyn CSD Tax Levy (Renewal and Increase)

On May 31, 2017 we conducted a Risk-Limiting Post-Election Audit for the May 2017 Primary Election. There were 46,569 total ballots cast in the election. A hand count was conducted of all 1,820 ballots cast in the audited contest. The accuracy rate for the post-election audit is 100%.

Our Risk-Limiting Audit was based upon the Kaplan-Markov method as explained by Philip B. Stark and Mark Lindeman. Auditing best practices recommend we split up the total ballots cast by precinct into multiple batch types. We utilized five batch types each consisting of one single ballot type category: Absentee, Election Day, Provisional, Post Absentee, and Post Election Day.
